4-H Fashion Revue



This contest is for Senior 4-H members 14-18 and must have passed their 14th birthday by December 31 of the previous year.

The Fashion Revue has three components; judging, staging workshop and a community service workshop. The contestants work through each of these components during the morning and afternoon sessions. All Contestants must be present for their judging session, rehearsal, and public show.

Contestants must model a garment, not accessories, made in clothing construction, artistic clothing, heritage arts or leathercraft or purchased the garment in the clothing buymanship project.

Counties can select three (3) qualified senior from their county fashion revue contest to compete at the state contest.

Contestants will be judged either in morning or afternoon session. A judging list will be emailed to the contestants on the Monday prior to the contest telling which session they are in (morning or afternoon).

During the judging, parents are free to leave or spend the day as they please. If parents choose to stay and watch, they must remain silent during the judging.

Group leaders -group leaders help take the groups of contestants from each component, judging, staging and community service workshop, and makes sure that each contestant looks good before the judging.
