This project is designed to teach 4-H members about Scrapbooking. The history of your life can be preserved for the next generation by creating a scrapbook filled with your collection of pictures and memorabilia. Scrapbooking is for members 8-18 years old.

- How to crop and mat photographs
- How to create a layout
- How to use embellishments to create your personal style
- Different techniques
- How to tell your story using pictures and journaling
