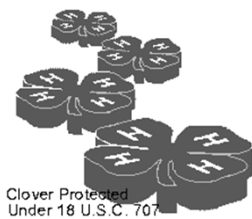

General Requirements Overview - Eric

- Club Practices and County Shoot
 - Cloverbuds (under age 8) not allowed to participate - no exceptions
 - CSU Liability Ruling
 - No Range access or assistance
 - No firearm or ammo handling
 - No target prep, setup, or tear down
 - Leaders must be certified 4H Leaders AND Have attended and passed Discipline specific 4H training
 - CSU Liability Insurance requirement

 - Practice cards

- Escalation path for questions or challenges
 - Done at the competition
 - Line Officer – 1st
 - Superintendent – 2nd
 - 4-H Agent – 3rd

Discipline specific highlights - Superintendents

Rifle Specific Safety Rules - Brenda

- Firing Line
 - Nothing in front of Firing Line and no more than 6" behind
- Clear Bore Indicators (C.B.I.'s)
 - 3" past muzzle and action
- Eye Protection
 - Competitors & Others
- Ear Protection (.22 Rifle only)
- Action Open (unless cased remain open)
- Cased Rifles until designated staging area or firing line
- Rifles Unloaded
 - 1 cartridge or pellet loaded at any time (including clip or magazine)
- Clothing

Muzzleloading - Troy

- Discipline specific items
 - Classes for county shoot
 - Firearm types
 - Additional Info - refer to rule book and CR

Shotgun - Shawn

- Classes and description for competition
 - Trap
 - Skeet
 - Sporting Clays
- Discipline specific items
 - Proper carrying positions
 - Eyes and Ears
 - Additional Items-- refer to rule book and CR

Western Heritage - Tyler

- Classes – Junior and Senior
- Competition
 - Cowboy Action Shooting – Timed shooting event
 - Persona – Character and Outfit Scoring
 - Old West History – Learn about the Old West and test your knowledge
- Rifle, Shotgun, and Pistol (over the age of 12)

Archery - Dawn

- Classes for Competition
- Discipline specific items
 - Bow type, weight, etc.
 - Arrow length
- Additional items, refer to rule book and CR

SS Project Discipline Highlights

- Rumor and Q&A time
 - Something that isn't clear
 - Something you thought you heard that needs explanation.
 - Question that you wrote down earlier

How to sign up for Exhibit Day and County Shoot – Tyler

- 2 Different registrations
- Must participate in Exhibit day to complete your 4H project
- County Shoot is optional
- If the 4H member wants to compete in County Shoot, they must also be registered for Exhibit Day
- If member is not available for Exhibit Day, they must make arrangements to turn in their Exhibit on that day (i.e. deliver to leader)

How to sign up for Exhibit Day and County Shoot – Tyler

- Exhibit Day – no live ammo, no broadheads, no arrow tips
- Stand Alone vs. Tri-fold Board projects
- Enrollment will be open by May 1 in ShoWorks
- Registrations are due June 13 – (more info in Thursday Blast and Council meeting minutes)
- Specific enrollment for rifle classes
 - Contact a superintendent or the Extension Office for help.
- 4H 201 - Will focus on Fair and Enrollment
