

2018 Douglas County 4-H Goat ID Form (Non-Market Goats)

Dairy, breeding, fiber, utility and non-microchipped pygmy goat projects please complete this information turn into the Extension Office by May 1st. *(This can also be done through your 4hOnline account by April 30th).*

YOU MUST REGISTER ANY GOATS YOU PLAN TO BRING TO FAIR TO SHOW IN ANY CLASS AS WELL AS OTHERS THAT ARE YOUR 4-H PROJECTS.

All Pygmy Goats with Microchips must come to ID day on May 1st starting at 4:00 pm to have their microchip read. They also must complete the Non-market goat identification form. Non-microchipped Pygmy goats must fill out the applicable identification form. Forms must be submitted to the Extension office by May 1st. Because pygmy goat is a county project, you must do a written form. The only exception is if a member does not know their microchip number. They can turn in hard copies of the form on May 1st at the identification day.

Dairy/Fiber/Utility/Breeding Goats: *Only market goats and Pygmy Goats that are microchipped must come to the fairgrounds to be tagged and/or ID'ed. Dairy, breeding, fiber, and utility goat members must turn in complete paperwork before May 1st to register your goat. Dairy, breeding, fiber, and utility members do not need to bring the actual goat unless it is cross-entered into the market class, for example a market goat being used as a utility goat. ID forms may be completed in 4honline (by April 30th) or hard copies sent to the 4-H office. (Because fiber goat is a county project, you must do a hard copy form to register your animals.)

4hOnline Upload Process:

For all NON-Market Goats (Except fiber and pygmy) you can enter your registration information through the online website. To fill out your goat identification form online, go to: co.4honline.com Sign in, go to your name, click "edit", then "animals/livestock", choose "Goat (and the appropriate project Dairy, market breeding, etc)", then click add animal. Fill out the information and save. Also add the Douglas County Goat Registration Information Form under the "County Use Form" section.
