# 2019 Colorado Gardener Certificate Training

The Colorado Gardener Certificate (CGC) program is a **10-week continuing education/training program** designed to educate interested people in the following horticulture areas:

- Botany (Study of Plants)
- Plant Pathology
- Lawn & Turf Care/Management
- Weed Management
- The Science of Planting Trees
- Tree Care
- Entomology (Insect and Pest management)
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
- Vegetables
- Pruning
- Soils
- Native Plants

**Program Focus:** The program is designed and taught by Colorado State University faculty and staff specializing in Colorado horticulture. CSU Extension manages the program in local counties. All information is evidence-based focused on the latest research and local Colorado climates and conditions.

**Program Format:** The CGC training follows our Colorado Master Gardener training and will consist of 6 in-person classes held on Tuesdays between January 29-April 2, 2019. Additionally, 4 trainings will be offered through an online classroom and must be done at home/work online. Additional online trainings will be made available to students, these are optional to complete. On-site locations include: Douglas County Fairgrounds (Castle Rock) and Arapahoe County Fairgrounds (Aurora).

**Reading Materials:** All reading materials will be provided online and can be downloaded, saved and printed as needed.

**Tuition** is \$530 (*There is a \$25 late fee if paid after 12/31/18*)
