

DOUGLAS COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Two (2) \$2,500.00 scholarship will be awarded each year to a recipient who is a graduating high school senior, who is an active Douglas County 4-H member, in good standing for a period of no less than 5 years.
2. A recipient will not be eligible to receive any other Douglas County 4-H Scholarships that are offered.
3. The applicant must have a minimum 2.9 high school cumulative grade point average.
4. Recipients wishing to renew their scholarship after attending one year of college will be required to have achieved a 2.8 cumulative grade point average or better. This scholarship may be renewed for up to three (3) additional years after recipient has received the initial scholarship, if all requirements are met, and funding is available. (Four (4) maximum funding for scholarship).
5. The Douglas County 4-H Foundation will notify all recipients, whose scholarships have been renewed.
6. There will be no restrictions as to the college, university or accredited trade school that is attended, in or out of the state of Colorado.
7. Recipients must maintain a full-time student status or trade school equivalent to be eligible for renewal of this scholarship.
8. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the school after school registration is confirmed and received by the scholarship committee.
9. The applicants will be asked to attend a personal interview before at least three (3) of the Foundation board members, before a final decision is determined.
10. Each recipient will be required to help with the Foundation's fund-raising efforts. This will be done by the recipient writing one (1) article for the local newspaper and attending at least one (1) local service organizational meeting or Foundation sponsored event. The subject matter will be "What you have gained from the experience that the scholarship money has made possible."
11. All items on the scholarship application must be complete and postmarked by the Foundation by all deadlines or the application will be null and void.
12. Application deadline will be **MARCH 1**.

THE DOUGLAS COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- 4-H experience, participation and achievements (50%)
- School and academic achievements (25%)
- Application and interview (25%)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS TO BE FILED WITH THE DOUGLAS COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION:

- Completed application form
- Official high school transcript
- Four (4) letters of recommendation
 - Two (2) from community leader, employer, friend or acquaintances (must be adults)
 - One (1) from high school teacher or counselor
 - One (1) from a 4-H leader or agent

REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWALS:

- Official college transcript – Fall & Spring transcripts
- Essay on your goals and achievements from the previous year addressed to the 4-H Foundation.
- Renewal application form available from the Douglas County Extension Office. (Application will consist of Cover Sheet and page 1 of the original application).
- Confirmation of re-enrollment in school for the Fall/Spring semester.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROCESSING SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENTS:

- To process scholarship payments to schools in a timely manner, the following deadlines should be met. After these deadlines, scholarship processing may be delayed significantly.
 - Fall Scholarship requests and all requirements must be submitted by July 1st each year to have payment at schools for fall tuition.
 - Spring Scholarship requests must be submitted by December 1st each year to have payment meet the schools spring tuition deadlines.
