

Douglas County 4-H Community Service Scholarship

The Douglas County 4-H Foundation, in cooperation with the Young Farmer's and Homemakers is offering a scholarship opportunity for Douglas County 4-H members. Your application and reference letters are due to the 4-H office by **April 1, 2019**.

This scholarship will be awarded based on the applicant's community service contribution and is limited to graduating high school seniors who are current 4-H members. This \$1000 scholarship will be available for use at any accredited institution of advanced education for the first year of enrollment.

This opportunity is designed to reward 4-H participants who have committed a significant amount of time and effort toward community service projects. Academic performance is not a major criterion.

Applicants will be required to submit two letters of recommendation and may be required to participate in an interview.
