Call or email the office and let us know if you want to help.



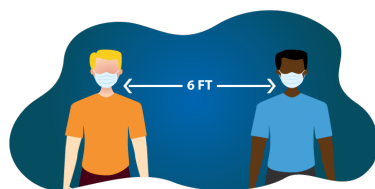
