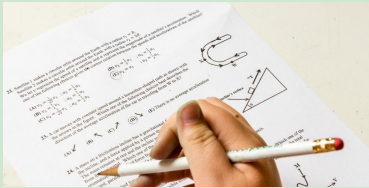

Senior Showcase



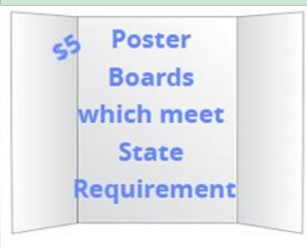
The Douglas County Extension Office wants to recognize our 4-H Seniors!!
