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Tips:

- The exhibit can be a display board and stand-alone item.
- The discipline that you select is the exhibit class that you will exhibit in.
- Proper shooting techniques work well for a display.
- No live ammo, broadheads, knives, or functional firearms can be used in the display.
- Do not use the word weapon when creating your display. Make sure there are no safety violations in your display (Examples of violations: no earplugs or no safety glasses on a photo of a youth firing his/her firearm.)
- Follows unit requirements and rules in the State Fair Exhibit Requirements
- Creative or artistic, and attractive
- Relatively simple and colorful
- Sturdy and educational
- Gives viewer the impression that you enjoyed your project
