4-H and CSU


- CSU is Colorado's Land Grant University


- Youth development organization

 - Citizenship





- 4-H is 365 days a year, not just that one day at fair or a contest



Roles within 4-H

- Community-based

- Youth officers and committees
- Monthly business meetings
- Requirements attendance, community service, fundraising, demonstrations, etc.






