



Registration is required on 4-HOnline before attending any Douglas County 4-H programming. Members will fill out an online COVID-19 Release Form upon 2021 enrollment in 4-HOnline.

Effective February 6, 2021 - Douglas County is in, "Safer at Home Level: Yellow". 4-H groups, clubs and programs are prohibited to meet in groups larger than 25. We strongly encourage moving to alternative & virtual options for all 4-H activities





Calling all fashionistas!


