

DOUGLAS COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Updated 1/16/2020

1. Applicant must have been a 4-H member in good standing in Douglas County for at least one (1) year, but they must show leadership in and commitment to the 4-H program over an extended period of time.
2. There are no restrictions as to college, university or accredited trade/vocational school which the individual plans to attend, in or out of the state of Colorado. There are no restrictions as to subject matter studied.
3. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale. Official transcripts from all schools attended and two (2) personal recommendations are required as part of the scholarship application. Please allow adequate time for these items to be sent.
4. Six (6) \$1000 scholarships awarded by Douglas County 4-H Youth Council will be given to the highest scoring high school seniors and currently enrolled college student applicants. **REMINDER! College students you can receive this scholarship three (3) times, but you must submit a new application each year, including updated transcripts and recommendations.**
5. Two (2) \$500 4-H Horse Scholarships are awarded to high school seniors with an outstanding horse record and meeting the above requirements who will be entering college in the fall. The application should reflect their horse accomplishments throughout their 4-H career. The application form for this scholarship is the same as the 4-H scholarship plus the horse supplement **must** be submitted. An additional letter of recommendation **must** be from a **horse** related reference. Winning this scholarship does not exclude you from receiving a 4-H scholarship and the same form may be filled out for both.
6. Scholarship monies must be used the school year immediately following awarding of scholarship. Monies will be mailed directly to the school when registration confirmation has been received by the 4-H office from the recipient.
7. You **must have official transcripts**, so we recommend you request these as soon as possible. It often takes schools a lengthy period of time to mail the requested transcript. The same applies for the **required** recommendations. Allow plenty of time for the individual to complete the form and return it. All items must be received by the published deadline.

****Please note: The completed application form, official transcripts, and required current recommendations for each type of scholarship must be received by the 4-H Extension Office by the deadline, or the application will not be considered.**

It is the applicant's responsibility to confirm with the 4-H office that all items have been received on time. Applicants will not be notified if something is missing.
