# **Shooting Sports**

If you are participating in County Shoot, you are required to have 3 certified practices per discipline (documented on those blue practice cards). For example, if you are competing in Air Rifle and .22 Rifle, you need 3 "Rifle" practices. This applies to Pistol as well. A certified practice is one where a certified 4-H Shooting Sports leader in that discipline is leading it. These practice cards are due to Nicole by Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup>\*\*\*. You can either drop them off at the office or scan them to Nicole.

in on the 13th.
