DOUGLAS COUNTY 4-H FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. For 2022, one (1) \$2,500.00 scholarship will be awarded each year to two recipients who are graduating high school seniors, who are an active Douglas County 4-H member, and who are in good standing for a period of no less than 5 years.
- 2. A recipient will not be eligible to receive any other Douglas County 4-H Scholarships that are offered.
- 3. A recipient would have to relinquish this scholarship, if they would be receiving any full ride scholarship from any other scholarship committee or school. (Full ride being all tuition, room and board being paid).
- 4. The applicant must have a minimum 2.9 high school cumulative grade point average.
- 5. Recipients wishing to renew their scholarship after attending one year of college will be required to have achieved a 2.8 cumulative grade point average or better. This scholarship may be renewed for up to three (3) additional years after recipient has received the initial scholarship, if all requirements are met, and funding is available. (Four (4) maximum funding for scholarship).
- 6. There will be no restrictions as to the college, university or accredited trade school that is attended, in or out of the state of Colorado.
- 7. Recipients must maintain a full time student status or trade school equivalent to be eligible for renewal of this scholarship.
- 8. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the school after 4-H Foundation receives your student ID and the address of the Financial Aid office of the school you will attend.
- 9. The applicants will be asked to attend a personal interview before at least three (3) of the Foundation board members, before a final decision is determined.
- 10. Each recipient will be required by the Douglas County 4- H Foundation to help with our fund raising efforts. This will be done by the recipient writing one (1) article for the local newspaper and attending at least one (1) local service organizational meeting or Douglas County 4-H Foundation sponsored event. The subject matter will be "What you have gained from the experience that the scholarship money has made possible."

- Confirmation of re-enrollment in school for the Fall/Spring semester.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROCESSING SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENTS:

- In order to process scholarship payments to schools in a timely manner, the following deadlines should be met. After these deadlines, scholarship processing may be delayed significantly.
 - Fall Scholarship requests and all requirements must be submitted by July 1st each year to have payment at schools for fall tuition.
 - Spring Scholarship requests must be submitted by December 1st each year to have payment meet the schools spring tuition deadlines.
