In the event you accept other scholarships exceeding \$5000 per year in any combinations, such acceptance would automatically cancel this scholarship. If this is the case, we would request that you notify us immediately as the scholarship will then be awarded to another worthy applicant.

Our stipend is a cash grant of two thousand dollars for one academic year and is payable in equal amounts each semester of that year. You may attend any accredited, state supported, public college or university in Colorado. You must complete 12 or more credit hours of college level work and maintain a GPA of 2.0. To receive the \$1000 stipend for Fall Semester a verification of enrollment from the registrar's office must be sent to the address below. The subsequent payment for Spring Semester will require a copy of your grades from Fall and a verification or enrollment for Spring also sent to the address below. This scholarship is renewable for a maximum of one year provided funding is available. See 'YF&H Renewal Application' form for details and qualification criteria.

To be eligible for scholarship consideration you must:

- 1. Be a current 4H member in good standing in Douglas County.
- 2. Complete the attached application.
- 3. Must be enrolling in an accredited, state supported, public College or University in Colorado for fall semester of your graduating year.

This application must be accompanied by three letters of recommendation: one from your high school principle or counselor, one from a Douglas County teacher, and one from someone other than a relative. An official transcript of your high school grades and SAT or ACT scores must accompany your application. A hard copy of the application and accompanying documents must be sent to the address below and be postmarked no later than April 1st.

We realize the importance of a college education and hope we can assist in accomplishing this worthy goal. Congratulations on your pending graduation.
