

Please see messaging from CO State Fair Livestock Manager regarding 2022 CSF livestock nominations

-The CO State Fair will accept retinal scans for beef, goats & lambs through 2024. Beginning 2025, all nominated animals will need to submit DNA. -If retinal scans are attached to the nomination forms in 2022, no DNA will need to be submitted for beef, goats and lambs. ALL market hogs will be required to submit DNA.

-DNA does not need to be attached to the nomination form. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to order and submit the DNA on their nominated animals. DNA envelopes will be available to be ordered beginning March 1st & will be due to the Colorado State Fair on the same day as nomination forms: Beef -April 1, Goats -June 1, Hogs -June 1, & Lambs -June 1. DNA envelopes cannot be ordered after May 16 -this allows mailing time both to the exhibitor and to the Colorado State Fair. Late DNA will not be accepted.

-If entries come into the Colorado State Fair that do not have required DNA, those entries will be rejected and no refunds will be issued.


