





May 22, 2024 – Date does should kindle July 31, 2024 – Market pen show date at fair.

4-H Rabbit Meat Pen member must own the doe(s) used for breeding. Youth may use a buck they do not own.

You must raise your own meat pen rabbits, you are not allowed to share rabbits with anyone else (including other family members) and are not permitted to purchase meat pens. Meat pens must be purebred/commercial breed type and each exhibitor may enter two pens. Youth must own the doe(s) but may use an outside buck. 
