



PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FEE \$7 per class; 3 classes for \$20; 5 classes for \$30 Day of Show Registration fee - add \$10 Registration is limited to 2 dogs per 4-H member

Check-in starts at 8:00 am: Judging starts at 9:00 am Written Showmanship Test will start at 8:30 am Judge will ask you questions in the ring about your breed

Dogs must be current on all vaccinations. All participants and dogs must be enrolled in the 4-H Dog Project. No pregnant or tactating dogs allowed. No dogs in season allowed. No dogs in obvious pain or illness allowed.





Attention Market Rabbit Raisers!!!

July 31, 2024 – Market pen show date at fair.

4-H Rabbit Meat Pen member must own the doe(s) used for breeding. Youth may use a buck they do not own.

You must raise your own meat pen rabbits, you are not allowed to share rabbits with anyone else (including other family members) and are not permitted to purchase meat pens. Meat pens must be purebred/commercial breed type and each exhibitor may enter two pens. Youth must own the doe(s) but may use an outside buck.
