- Returning 4-H members who enroll and pay dues BEFORE DECEMBER 31ST will pay \$60 each
- Returning 4-H members who enroll and pay dues AFTER DECEMBER 31ST will pay \$85 each
 - \$60 Enrollment Fee + \$25 Late Fee after December 31st = \$85
- New 4-H members are able to enroll until March 1st, 2025, without a late fee, \$60 each
- All 4-H members must enroll by March 1st, 2025, NO EXCEPTIONS
- All Cloverbuds (ages 5-7) will be \$40 each, year-round.

ALL MEMBERS MUST BE ENROLLED AND PAID BY MARCH 1ST, 2025. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS
